ABOUT THE COLLEGE LIBRARY

North Lakhimpur College Library was established with the College Establishment with a minimum no. of Collection of books. But now Library being the heart of academic pursuit, the college provides a spacious, accommodative and resourceful library with about 50,000 Nos of text and reference books, 32 Nos Journals of national, regional and local levels, 5000 e-journals and more than 80,000 e-books, reprography and computers with Internet facilities accessible to students and teachers. The Library has running by computer Automation by using the software SOUL 2.0 version. The North Lakhimpur College Library is also a member of N-List Programme of INFLIBNET. In 2015 the College Library has started the digitalised form of Library system from where Library User / Reader can access and download the uploaded college library books, old question papers etc. The Library has organized an Annual Book Reading Competition among the students and the Best Reader has been awarded with a special prize.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE SEMINAR ON: ELECTRONIC (E) - RESOURCE MANAGEMENT IN LIBRARIES:

E-Resource Management (ERM) is the practices and software systems used by libraries to keep track of important information about electronic information resources, especially internet based resources such as electronic journals, databases and electronic books. The development of EMR became necessary in the early 2000s as it became clear that traditional library catalogue and integrated library systems were not designed to handle metadata for resources as changing as many online products are. The impact of the digital environment on library collections, providing access to electronic resources, and the need to image hybrid collections of print and electronic resources are ongoing challenges. The increasing demand for electronic resources has resulted in the need for more librarians and library staff devoted to job functions related to planning, selecting, implementing and evaluating electronic resources. An understanding of the nuances of copyright law and its relationship with other areas of library law is critical for anyone whose responsibilities include electronic resource management which today encompasses almost everyone.

A problem many libraries have had with managing collections of electronic resources is managing different pieces of relevant information. Licences, contracts, payment information and access rights are often recorded in different format media and stored in multiple library departments. Administering this collection of management data is cumbersome and time consuming. This required broad-based cooperation and communication among library units. Along the way, many old decisions and processes were re-examined and new procedures, workflow, and staffing assignments were made better handle the new electronic environment. Several factors have rendered the job of librarians who deal with electronic resources extremely challenging, the amazing growth of electronic collections, the increasingly central role that these collections play in libraries, the large budget that are involved in their acquisition, the endless variation in the packages offered by the hundreds of players in the market (such as publishers, interface providers, and subscription agencies), the frequent change in business management. It is with this background, North Lakhimpur College Library and GEA Education, North Lakhimpur Study Centre are going to organizing two days National Seminar.

Hence, the aims and objectives of the Seminar are-

1. To create awareness on electronic resource management among the librarians and library professionals.
2. To critically analysis the problems related to electronic resource management.
3. To find out the different research activities which are going on electronic resource management and related topic.
