Sub:- Sanction of an "on account" grant to identified college under the scheme of "Colleges with Potential for Excellence" (CPE).

Sir/ Madam,

This is in continuation of this office D.O. letter No.F.12-1/2008 (NS/PE) dated 18th March, 2010 addressed to Vice-Chancellors and copy marked to the Principal to the concerned colleges regarding selection of colleges under CPE Scheme.

In this regard, I am to convey the sanction of the Commission for payment of Rs.50,00,000/- (Rupees fifty lakhs only) to North Lakhimpur College, Lakhimpur, Dist.- Lakhimpur, (Assam) an "on account" grant for (a) improving academic infrastructure, (b) adopting innovations in teaching, learning and evaluation and (c) initiating the activities under the scheme of CPE. The final details will be spelt out after an interface meeting with Expert Committee, details of which will be sent to the Colleges in due course. In the meanwhile, the Colleges may prepare an Action Plan in line with the XI Plan Guideline of CPE.

The details of an "on account" grant being released are given below:-

* The above allocation is as per the guidelines on CPE. In case, your college has obtained autonomous status after submission of your proposals under CPE scheme, kindly send a copy of UGC letter conferring autonomous status so that the above allocation may be revised.

The sanctioned amount is debitable to the Major Head 3. (iii) and is valid for payment during the financial year 2009-2010 only.

The above amount may be kept in a separate Saving Bank A/c of your Bank.

The above grant may be utilized only after receiving the approval from UGC with reference to your budget Proposal for the years 2010-2011 to 2011-2012. The Visiting Committee shall visit each of the provisionally recommended colleges to discuss and finalize the Action Plan and Budget of the College for CPE Scheme. Further details of visit will be sent to the College(s) in due course.

The Grant is subject to the adjustment on the basis of Utilization Certificate in the prescribed proforma submitted by the University / Colleges/ Institution.

The College shall maintain proper accounts of the expenditure out of the Grants which shall be utilized only on approved items of expenditure.

The utilization certificate to the effect that the grant has been utilized for the purpose for which it has been sanctioned shall be furnished to the University Grants Commission as early as possible after the close of the current financial year.

The assets acquired wholly or substantially out of University Grants Commission's Grant shall not be disposed or encumbered or utilized for the purposes other than those for which the Grant was given, without proper sanction of the University Grants Commission and should, at any time the College ceased to function, such assets shall revert to the University Grants Commission.

A Register of Assets acquired wholly or substantially out of the Grant shall be maintained by the University / College in the prescribed form.


The grantee institution shall ensure the utilization of grants-in-aid for which it is being sanctioned / paid. In case non-utilization/part utilization, the simple interest @ 10% per annum as amended from time to time on unutilized amount from the date of drawl to the date of refund as per provisions contained in General Financial Rules; of Govt. of India will be charged.

10. The College shall follow strictly all the instructions issued by the Government of India from time to time with regard to reservation of posts for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes.
11. The College shall fully implement to official Language Policy of Union Govt. and comply with the Official Language Act, 1963 and Official Languages (Use for Official purposes of the Union) Rules, 1978 etc.
12. The sanction issues in exercise of the delegation of powers vide Commission office Order No. 25/92 dated May 01,1992.

You may be happy to know that your College is one among the 149 Colleges identified under the scheme "**Colleges with Potential for Excellence**" (CPE) during phase-III. I do hope that you would have received the letter sent to your Vice-Chancellor and copy marked to you in this regard. The information regarding your college selection and other details have also been posted on the UGC website (www.ugc.ac.in).

Kindly arrange to send a certificate to the fact that the data provided by your College in the proposal are factually correct, if not sent earlier. It may be noted that in case it is found to be incorrect at a later stage then the CPE status conferred on your college may be revoked, as per the provisions of the CPE XI plan guidelines. Your Action Plan proposal shall be processed only on receipt of this certificate.

You may kindly note that the Expert Committee will be visiting to your College for an on-the-spot evaluation shortly, the details of which will be sent to you in due course. Therefore, I request you to kindly prepare an Action Plan as per prescribed proforma given in the XI Plan (CPE) Guideline in ANNEXURE-II and prepare ten copies of the same for placing before the Expert Committee. You may kindly note that 60% of your Budget need to be spent on Non-Recurring and 40% on Recurring items. Since the tenure of the scheme is only for XI Plan period, no building component be included in the Budget.



It was also observed during the discussion that certain colleges are still working as a Composite College. In such cases, the CPE funds should be used only for the Degree/P.G. programmes and not for the "+2" programme. A certificate to this effect may also kindly be sent to this office and appropriate action should be taken to delink '+2' programmes from the college at the earliest.
