### 6. Brief Report of the Extension Activity

Including the outcome of the activity : It was a follow up extension program of the 1<sup>st</sup> extension activity (survey) conducted in the village on 13/5/2022 by the UBA cell. Extension program on " Importance of Deworming " on the occasion of District Level Launching of National Deworming Day and a Free Health Camp have been conducted today on 10<sup>th</sup> March, 2023 by UBA Cell and NSS unit of North Lakhimpur College at UBA adopted Pratapgarh village, Lakhimpur. This program has been conducted in collaboration with District Health Society, Office of the Joint Director of Health Services, Lakhimpur. This program has been organized as a follow up action after baseline household survey conducted by college NSS unit. More than 100 villagers have undergone treatment under a medical team provided by National Health Mission, Lakhimpur. The team offered laboratory services by MMU and also provided drugs to beneficiaries. As a part of launching NDD, more than fifty preschool and school age children have been provided with deworming drug Albendazole.
