Points for consideration:

- 1) The departments shall arrange for conducting Seminars/ Workshops from time to time for academic augmentation of the institution.
- 2) Field work, if any, shall be arranged by the departments in line with academic credits and event dates/ periods mentioned in the academic calendar.

- 3) The holidays shall remain the same as that notified in the Holiday List issued by Dibrugarh University.
- 4) As per Government of Assam directive if any class is cancelled or could not be conducted for any reason (other than the pre-notified holidays/ non-class days), the same shall have to be adjusted in the subsequent Sunday.
- 5) The teaching departments/ programmes are to inform the students that the internships of up to 4 credit weightages are to be preferably completed in the month of July, 2025. In case the students find it difficult to locate internship avenues, the students/ mentor teachers/ department or programme Heads may bring it to the notice of competent authority.
- 6) In case of any requirement to change the time frame of any event mentioned in the academic calendar on an urgent basis, the same shall be discussed in a meeting of Heads of the departments immediately and suggestions may be sought from the other members through e-mail etc. The Principal shall have the discretion to adopt and implement necessary measures in order to ascertain the mandated number of teaching and working days in the institution.
- 7) EVERY TEACHING DEPARTMENT/ PROGRAMME SHALL HAVE TO ORGANIZE ONE PARENT-GUARDIAN MEETING WITHIN THE ACADEMIC YEAR.**
- 8) If any need for rectification/ modification of the academic calendar arises, the same shall be placed before all members for necessary suggestions.
