## Proceeding of the IQAC meeting with the HODs held on 12/10/2017.

The Review meeting of the IQAC as scheduled earlier regarding the progress of the SSR preparation for the upcoming NAAC visit to the college was held on 12/10/2017. Before the meeting at the outset the Co-ordinator IQAC, Mr. Atanu Gogoi initiated the meeting formally requesting the Principal to preside over the meeting formally. The co-ordinator informs the honorable member present the meeting does not have any extensive agenda. He further appeals the members to devise effective ways in compiling the data provided by the various departments. He further expresses his displeasure with some department which have not yet submitted their 4-compiled report assigned to them. The Principal wanted to know from the HOD, Asomese the reasons for failing in sending the data sought from them by various dept. In response to the query, the HOD replied that the department ~~has~~ has not done it intentionally but by mistake, The Principal requested her to take the matter seriously and to do the needful for collective welfare of the college.

Dwelling on the necessity of formation of a strong Review and Drafting Committee for preparation of the SSR to be submitted to the NAAC Peer Team and requested the members present to form the said committee. He requested all the members to give their individual opinions. Dr. Jiten Dutta, HOD, Electronics to entrust the responsibility upon the former committee.



Dr. B. Bhuyan, one of the members of the former committee, expressed his reluctance in being included into the new committee expressing his little disappointment in an unscrupulous allegation levelled against him for not being fit to even to write a memorandum. The same displeasure and anger was expressed by another member of the former committee.

The Principal requested the displeased members not to repeat such (in investigative) inflammatory slogan and allegations made by the students. The Co-ordinator, NAAC wanted to know if the formal/ informal nature of the Committee would make the NAAC preparation a failure, to which the Principal assures that the former members would be officially formally and no individual liability would have to be imposed upon them.
