North Lakhimpur College Research Admission Test- 2021

North Lakhimpur College Research Admission Test- 2021 is scheduled to be held on 05.10.2021 for admission into M.Phil. Programme in <u>Assamese</u> [Total no of seats: **06** (**six**)] & in <u>Political Science</u> [Total no of seats: **02** (**two**)]

Eligibility Criteria:

- 1. A candidate intending to appear in the NLCRAT 2021 for admission to the M.Phil Programme shall have to obtain at least 55% marks OR equivalent grade point in the Master Degree (Assamese).
- **2.** A relaxation up to 5% marks or an equivalent relaxation of grade in the qualifying degree is allowed for candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC (none creamy layer) and differently-Abled category.
- **3.** As per latest UGC guidelines NLCRAT is exempted only for UGC-NET (including JRF) qualified Candidates.

Application Procedure:

- 1. For submission of Online Application Form please visit www.nlc.ac.in.
- 2. The applicant shall be required to pay the NLCRAT fee of `600/- only through the online payment gateway.

Admission Procedure:

- 1. The eligible candidates shall have to apply for admission through online mode (college website).
- 2. For selection of candidates a weightage of 70% from NLCRAT score and 30% from the Viva-voce/ Interview shall be given.
- 3. The Chairperson, DRC shall place the applications in the meeting of the Departmental Research Committee. The Departmental Research Committee shall conduct an interview of the applicants and finalize the list of eligible applicants for admission in the department.
- 4. The concerned Departmental Research Committee shall allocate supervisors to each scholar at the time of admission.
- 5. Admission Fee- `20,000/- only (excluding examination fee)

About Examination:

The NLCRAT shall be conducted in a single paper which shall comprise of two parts- (a) 50% on Research Methodology /Research Aptitude (Group A) and (b) 50% from Core Course Components of the subject concerned (Group B). The paper shall carry 100 marks and duration of examination shall be of two and half hours.

The pattern of the Question Papers shall be as below-

- i. Type Objective Multiple Choice = 50% from Group A and 50% from Group B. There will be no negative marking.
- ii. Descriptive Type = 50% from Group A and 50% from Group B
